Erector Training

We have three 2-week scaffold erector courses for students with different levels of experience: **Introduction, Intermediate and Qualification.**

All the courses have been designed to comply with BC's OH&S, CSA's Standard for Access Scaffold (Z797-09) and manufacturer's recommendations. The courses cover all aspects of scaffold building:

- regulations and requirements
- terminology
- hazards and assessments
- foundations and bases
- bracing and tying
- platforms and access
- loads and duty ratings
- putlogs
- inspections

All courses deal with frame, manufactured system and tube and clamp construction, with the projects in the hands-on portion of the courses increasing in challenge and complexity. Multi-bay and multi-level scaffolds, buttresses and cantilevers, ladder cages, and stairs are built in all three courses. Bridges, hanging scaffolds and hanging cantilevered scaffolds are covered in the Qualification course. At least 10 projects are constructed in each course, and there are both written and practical tests as required by CSA.



User Awareness & Inspection Training

In the inspection course, we teach general rules and hazards of scaffolds, allowable and applied loads, and inspection and tagging systems, as well as the general requirements of fall protection and personal protective equipment. This course can be customized for your site specific requirements.
